Course content	In this German course the following topics will be worked on: introducing oneself, my family, shopping, my flat, my day, activities in my spare time. Concerning the grammar, the following issues will be treated: conjugation of verbs, making questions, prepositions, possessive pronouns, personal pronouns, plural, negation, cases (Accusative), modal verbs.
Learning outcomes	After successfully attending this German course, students will be able to <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • give basic personal information and establish contacts with others • speak about topics related to their personal and everyday life, such as introducing yourself, family, hobbies and sports. • read and understand simple texts • take part in simple conversations • use fundamental vocabulary and basic grammar structures that enable unsophisticated spoken and written communication in everyday situations.
